MCNABB CENTER BREAKS GROUND ON MINERAL SPRINGS MANOR



he McNabb Center celebrated the groundbreaking of Mineral Springs Manor on Friday, December 18th, 2020. Mineral Springs Manor will offer 50 one-bedroom units of much needed low-income permanent housing to senior citizens in the Knoxville area.

This unique housing program will provide independent living to seniors experiencing issues with the aging process. It can offer supportive services that help seniors retain their independence and maintain their safety.

This nearly \$8 million project is possible because of the financial support of Knoxville's Community Development Corporation, the Helen Ross McNabb Foundation, the City of Knoxville, Knox County, Federal Home Loan Bank-Cincinnati, the Tennessee Housing Development Agency and numerous private donors.

66 Knoxville is in need of housing options for low-income senior citizens," said Jerry Vagnier, McNabb Center president and CEO. "We are excited to begin construction on this project and work to address that need in our community."

TAMHO HONORS MARY KATSIKAS WITH DOROTHEA DIX AWARD

ary Katsikas, senior director of children & youth mental health programming, was awarded the Tennessee Association of Mental Health Organizations' (TAMHO) 2020 Dorothea Dix Community Service Award because of her extensive contributions in the field of behavioral health. Dorothea Dix was a renowned champion of improved care for the mentally ill and is often regarded as the most influential force in bringing the issue of mental health to the public forum. Mary has followed in Dorothea's footsteps, changing the way children, young adults and families are treated throughout the East Tennessee region, the state and even at an international level.

For 20 years Mary has dedicated her work to improving the lives of the people she serves by changing the way systems work together to best benefit the client. She began her career working as a frontline staff member for the McNabb Center's school-based services, where her focus was with the seriously emotionally disturbed population. Her primary goal was to bridge the gap between the school, the home and to assess mental health needs. Now, as a senior director, Mary oversees a large division of services. Her scope of responsibility includes directing the Center's primary prevention services; Healthy Families, Therapeutic Preschool, Regional Intervention Program, school-based services, family treatment services, children and youth outpatient services and intensive mental health programming.

Dorothea Dix Award, Mary was also presented with the TAMHO Volunteer Leadership Award in 2020 as well as receiving the honor once before in 2018.

MOBILE CLINIC BUS JOINS CHRISTMAS PARADE

n December 12th, 2020 McNabb Center's new Mobile Health Clinic bus and staff were invited to participate in the New Market Christmas parade.

The Mobile Health Clinic, which is part of Project Rural Recovery, helps to break down barriers of accessing traditional health care. The clinic integrates primary care and mental health/substance use treatment, in order for health needs to be addressed in one place.

Adults, children and families served will be screened to determine if they have, or are at-risk of having, a chronic health condition, in addition to receiving a mental health or substance use assessment.

The Mobile Health Clinic provides preventative health screenings, including TB, HIV and Hepatitis. The clinic treats underserved rural communities in order to improve health outcomes. Integrated healthcare is provided in the Mobile Health Clinic, and specialty care is referred to local providers. The bus is a gateway to expanding medical care in rural communities.
